How can you suspend judgment when it comes to choices your loved ones make?

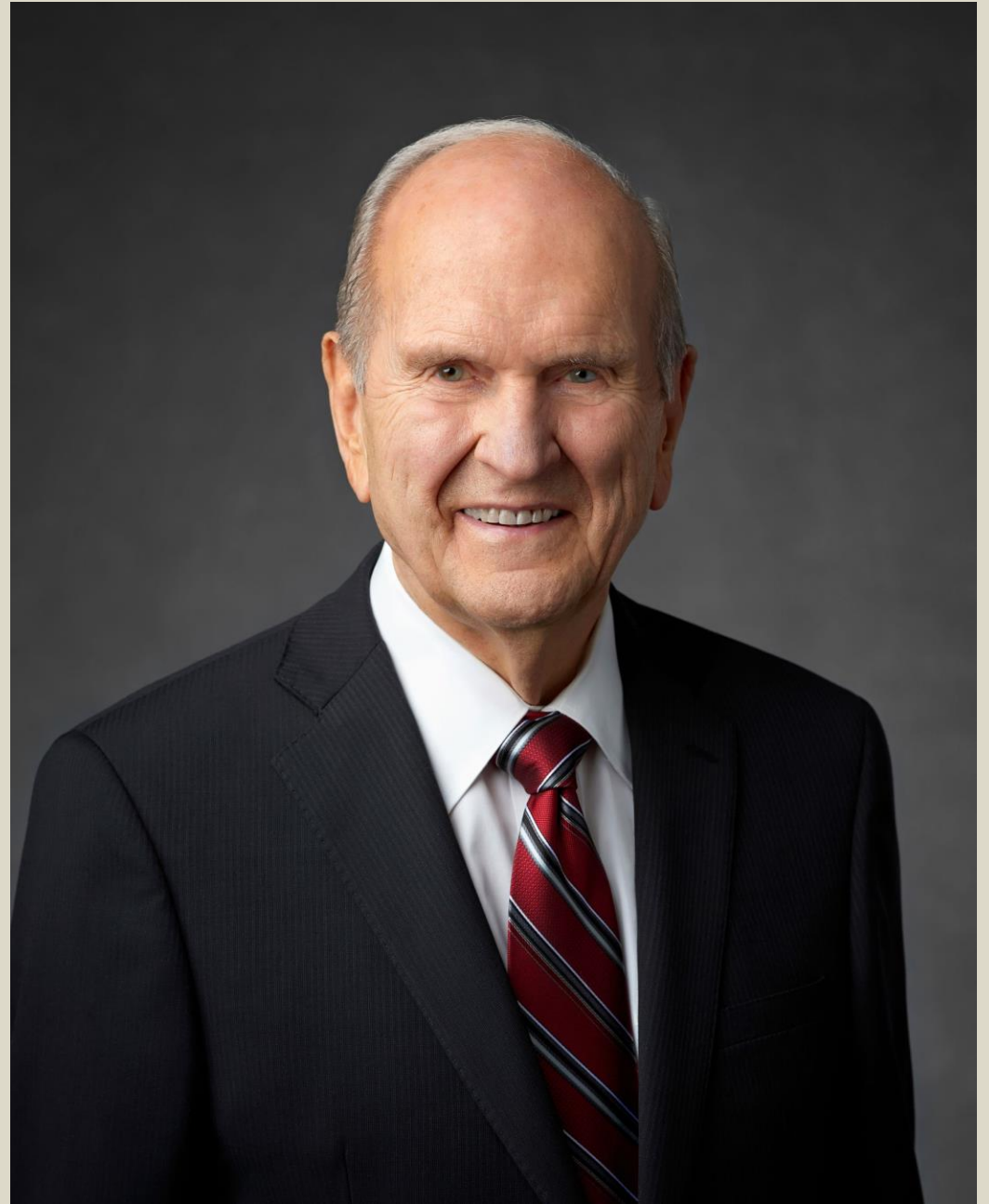
